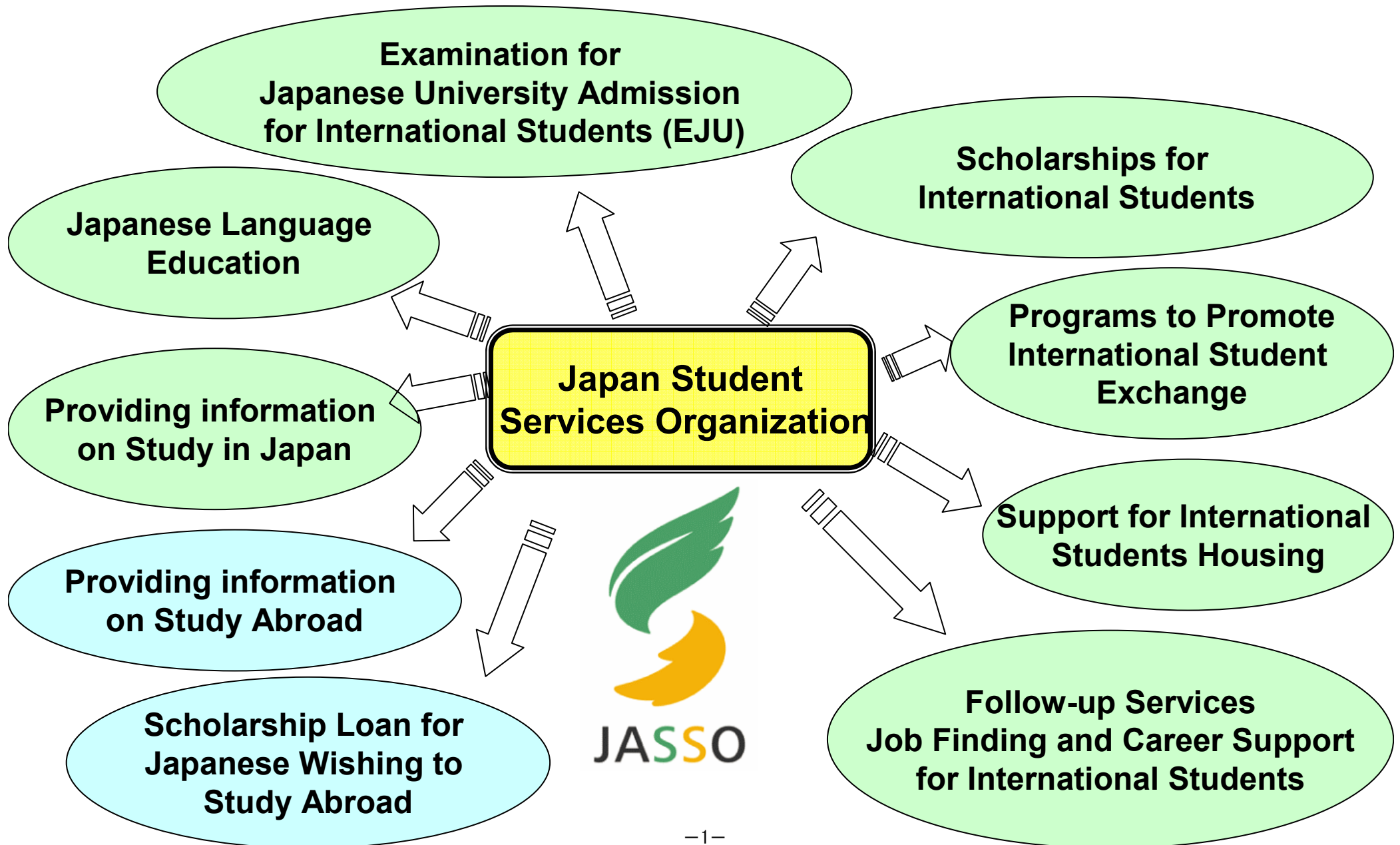

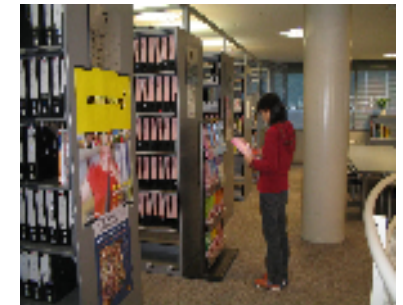

【Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students】

- Date of exam: Twice a year (June and November)
- Total applicants: about 40,000 per year
- Venues: (Japan) 15 prefectures, (Overseas) 16 cities in 13 countries and regions
- Subjects: Japanese as a Foreign Language, Science(2 subjects chosen from Physics, Chemistry and Biology), Japan and World, Mathematics
- Promoting pre-arrival admission
- EJU scores remain valid for two years
