

Q&A on the Nitori Scholarship

Q: If I will be starting my first year of university in April 2026, which means I won't be able to submit my passport page for entry into Japan during this document submission period, will I still be able to apply for this scholarship?

A: Yes. You can apply.

Q: Thank you for providing the information. I am First year student. I would like to ask about the Academic Performance Transcript. My GPA will be announced on 27 of February so Should I send the High School Transcript instead?

A: Please upload your high school records first and later send your final official record.

NOTE: The application guidelines have been updated. Please confirm the latest deadline and contact us individually if necessary.

Q: Is there any plan for a similar scholarship for 2027 onwards, for both master and doctoral degree? Thank you

A: Right now, it is only applicable for undergrad and master's. More details for FY 2027 will come out at the end of FY 2026.

Q: So, we need to apply to the Japanese university first, right? Then this scholarship?

A: You are right.

Q: I received the JASSO scholarship the previous year. Am I still eligible for this scholarship?

A: As long as the total amount received is under 150,000 yen it will be OK.
